Your responsibilities

- Receiving, labeling, processing, and analyzing specimens as well as storing or transporting specimens using appropriate preservation methods.
- Following standard operating procedures, performing any of the tests within any of the laboratory specialties. Calculating the results of the tests performed if necessary.
- Operating, calibrating, conducting performance checks, and maintaining any clinical laboratory instrument or equipment.
- Recognizing and correcting basic instrument malfunctions. Notifying supervisory personnel when appropriate.
- Conducting established quality control procedures on analytical tests, equipment, reagents; evaluating results of quality control and implements corrective action when indicated.
- Performing comparison studies of precision, accuracy, and linearity on new or existing procedures and reporting results in an established format.
- Establishing and monitoring safety programs in compliance with laboratory regulations.
- Utilizing laboratory information systems or other methods to report patient results accurately and effectively.
- Writing laboratory or standard operating procedures conforming to standardized format.
- Performing clinical orientation and supervision for trainees and new or less skilled laboratory personnel.
- Supporting other facility laboratories as needed to support clinical trial biomarker testing and nonclinical assay validation and sample testing.
